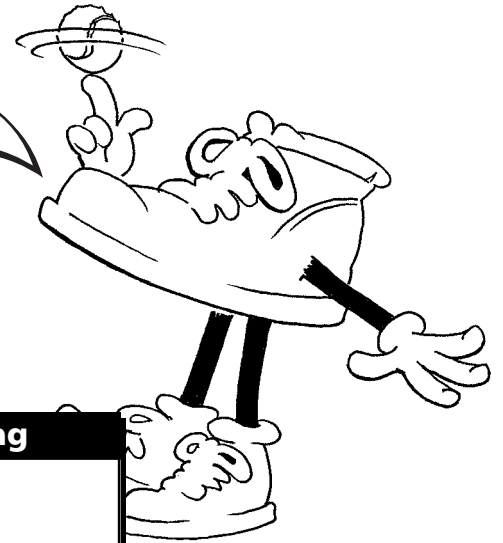


The four major tennis tournaments in the world are called the Grand Slams.  
Each takes place in a different city and country.

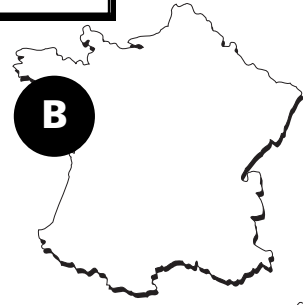
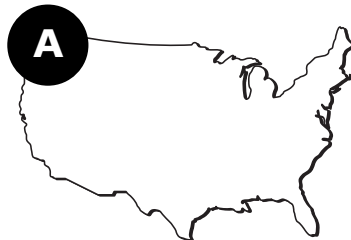
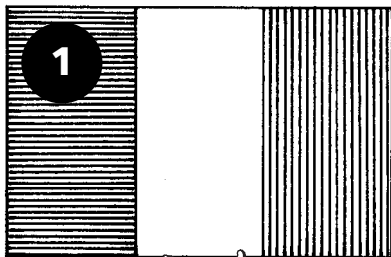

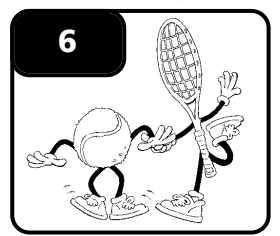
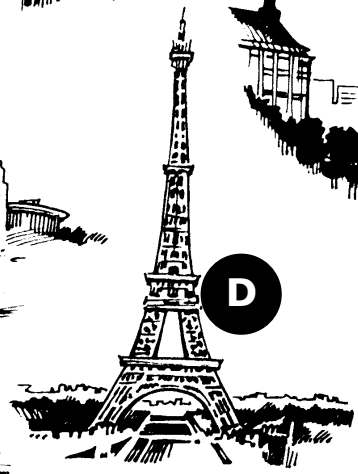
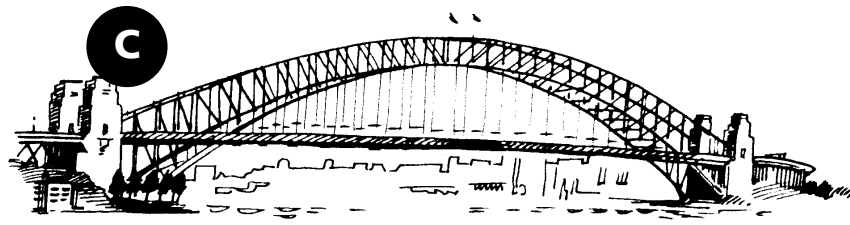
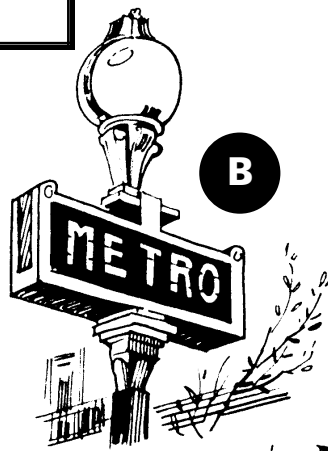
Many people who go to a Grand Slam tournament make it a part of a holiday. The cities and countries are very popular with tourists.

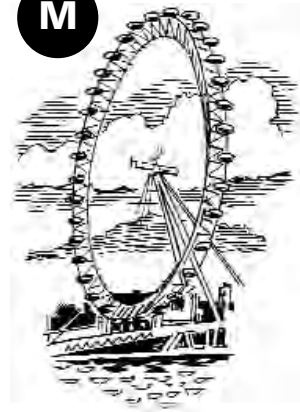

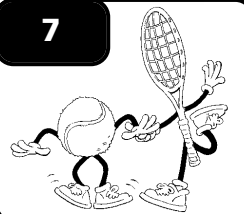
